Wraparound Care for Nursery children from September 2026

We would like to thank those who participated in our recent survey regarding wrap-around care for our Nursery children.

After careful consideration of the booking commitments received, we have had to make the difficult decision not to proceed with the service for the September 2026 term. Our requirement for a sustainable service, staffed by qualified practitioners, rests on a minimum enrolment of six children for four days a week. As the current interest stands at three children for limited hours, we are unable to fulfil the operational requirements at this time.

We recognise the impact this may have on your planning. Many of our families successfully utilise local childminders who are familiar with our school. See below for the list of local providers.

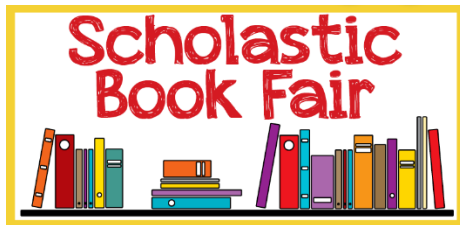

Dear Parents,

Re: School Health Night-Time Wetting Workshops to Support School-Aged Children

We are writing to introduce our *Night-Time Wetting Workshops for Parents and Carers*, designed to support families whose children are experiencing bedwetting at night.

Wetting the bed at night is common and is not caused by parental failure, laziness, or a lack of willpower. However, it can affect a child's confidence and emotional wellbeing.

School health is offering workshops approximately every six weeks until the end of the summer term. **The next date is the 24th of March.** The workshop aims to provide practical advice, reassurance, and evidence-based strategies to help children achieve night-time dryness in a supportive and positive way.
