### Mayor's School Filter Programme

We are thrilled to share that our school has been selected to participate in the Mayor's School Filter Programme. As part of a landmark initiative by the Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan, to improve air quality for children across the capital, clean air filters are being provided to classrooms in up to 200 schools. We have received our free, high-efficiency filters, and will be install them across our classrooms. By filtering out harmful pollutants and particulate matter, these devices will help create a healthier, safer, and more focused learning environment for all of our children and staff.
